## About the award-winner: JANET NEUMANN

A Montgomery County resident for 32 years, Janet Neumann started as a volunteer with Gaithersburg HELP in 2002 after she retired from her nursing career. She began as a food coordinator but became an Rx coordinator when others realized she had a medical background. When the Director Rx/Financial moved from the area, Janet assumed that role and has served in that capacity for 16 years. Simultaneously, she has promoted Gaithersburg HELP's services (food, infant needs, transportation and prescriptions) at many City events, such as the Active Aging Expo, Gaithersburg Day, Holiday Giving Program, and Homeless Resources Day. When HELP's former grants writer moved west, Janet took on that additional responsibility with great success. She worked on a team to prepare and implement a new Gaithersburg HELP website in 2017. She designed and delivered a training course for the new client database software implemented in January 2018.

For the past 10 years, Janet has served as a Board Member for Upper Montgomery Assistance Network, a sister organization working to prevent evictions and utility disconnections. Over the years, Janet has built strong relationships with the City's Community Services Division and with members of the City Council through her collaborative spirit and willingness to share her expertise and experience.
