

Need help with your electric and/or heating bill?

The Maryland Energy Assistance Program (MEAP) provides bill assistance to low-income households in the State of Maryland to make their energy costs more affordable, to help prevent loss of service and to restore home energy services.

Applications for the Office of Home Energy Programs are accepted at any time during the year (July 1st – June 30th). However, applications are only processed July 1st – May 31st. **To receive assistance for this year (FY20), applications must be submitted by May 31st.** Applications submitted after June 1st will be held for next year's cycle, beginning July 1st. To apply for **next year's program, submit an application after June 1st.** Submitting both applications will allow approved households to receive both a FY20 and a FY21 grant.
